The United States and Pakistan have a strong economic and commercial relationship, conducting twoway trade of approximately \$5.3 billion in 2013. The U.S. is Pakistan's largest trading partner and its leading source of foreign direct investment. For the U.S., Pakistan represents a modest market with suppliers exporting goods and services worth \$1.65 billion to Pakistan in 2013. This figure represents a 7 increase over the 2012 figure of \$1.53 billion. The U.S was Pakistan s largest export market in 2013, accounting for almost 15 of total exports. Valued at \$3.68 billion, Pakistan's exports to the U.S. in 2013 were 1.6 greater than the previous year. Overall, Pakistan s economic growth has been sluggish for the past four years, however it accelerated moderately in fiscal year 2012-13, growing by 4.1. Severe energy shortfalls, domestic security issues, burgeoning public debt, and the slow pace of economic and tax reform implementation are major factors that continue to pose a challenge to the economy of Pakistan.
